Measure Description:

Modifies laws regarding establishment of parentage of child.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD)

Analysis:

Senate Bill 512 modifies statutes that establishes parent relationships to apply gender-neutral language.

In addition to modifying forms, OHA will need to modify data elements in information technology systems. These systems include the Client Maintenance system (CM), Client Index (CI), OR-Kids, the Oregon Eligibility System (ONE) and the Integrated Eligibility (IE) System. OHA estimates the cost of changing all these data elements priced as a discrete project requiring an outside vendor to be \$528,120 Total Funds for the Office of Information Services (\$52,812 General Fund and \$475,308 Federal Funds). The Office of Information Services (OIS) is shared services, and the Other Funds amount reflects how the agency accounts for shared services.

Oregon Judicial Department (OJD)

The fiscal impact of this bill to OJD is minimal. OJD will need to modify forms and business processes, including changes to Odyssey codes. However, OJD will make these changes with existing resources.

This bill requires budgetary action for allocation of General Fund resources.
