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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Measure clarifies duties and language relating to the standards for the delegation of patient care tasks and modifies the categories of stakeholders that the Board may engage with during the rulemaking process that governs the administration of noninjectable medication to include all appropriate stakeholders. Effective date January 1, 2018.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Outdated statutes
- Language update to reflect current nurse license exam methods

**BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon State Board of Nursing regulates the nursing profession in Oregon including: determining licensure and certification requirements, evaluates and approves nursing education programs and nursing assistant training programs, issues licenses and renewals, investigates complaints and conducts investigations and other responsibilities outlined in ORS 678.150.
