**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Prohibits person, public body or local service district from constructing bridge [on] **crossing** Deschutes River within certain [segments] **segment** of Deschutes Scenic Waterway.

**Authorizes construction by person, public body, local service district or federal government of pedestrian and bicycle bridge crossing Deschutes River within certain segment of Deschutes Scenic Waterway.**

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A person, a public body as defined in ORS 174.109 or a local service dis-**  
5 **trict as defined in ORS 174.116 may not construct a bridge crossing the segment of the**  
6 **Deschutes Scenic Waterway established under ORS 390.826 that begins at the urban growth**  
7 **boundary of the City of Bend at river mile 172 and extends downstream one mile to the**  
8 **Central Oregon Irrigation District's diversion structure at river mile 171.**

9 **(2) A person, a public body as defined in ORS 174.109, a local service district as defined**  
10 **in ORS 174.116 or the federal government may construct a pedestrian and bicycle bridge**  
11 **crossing the segment of the Deschutes Scenic Waterway established under ORS 390.826 that**  
12 **begins at the urban growth boundary of the City of Bend at river mile 172 and extends up-**  
13 **stream approximately 520 feet.**
