

# House Bill 2172

Sponsored by Representative STARK (at the request of James Klein) (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires person that engages in business in this state, on premises onto which person permits members of public to enter, to post in prominent location outside entry to premises sign that states person's policy with respect to permitting individuals who have license to carry concealed handgun to carry firearm onto premises.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. A person that engages in business in this state, on premises onto which the**  
6 **person in the ordinary course of the person's business permits members of the public to**  
7 **enter, shall post in a prominent location outside the entry to the premises a sign that states**  
8 **the person's policy with respect to permitting individuals who have a license to carry a**  
9 **concealed handgun to carry a firearm onto the premises.**
