

House Bill 2590

Sponsored by Representative HAYDEN, Senators KRUSE, PROZANSKI; Representatives LIVELY, NEARMAN (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to issue grant to organization dedicated to addressing community needs relating to October 1, 2015, shooting on campus of Umpqua Community College.

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Department of Administrative Services.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to community recovery after the tragedy at Umpqua Community College; and declaring an
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
6 **ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July**
7 **1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3 million for the purposes of carrying out**
8 **the requirements of section 2 of this 2017 Act.**

9 **SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall issue a grant**
10 **in the amount of \$3 million to an organization that is dedicated to addressing community**
11 **needs relating to the October 1, 2015, shooting on the campus of Umpqua Community College.**

12 **(2) The organization shall use grant funds to assess and address community needs.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
