House Bill 3026

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to conduct study regarding funding for septic systems. Requires department to report findings to interim committee of Legislative Assembly no later than October 1, 2018.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to septic systems.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall conduct a study to assess the availability, sources, criteria and terms of funding related to the installation, up-keep, repair or replacement of septic systems, including but not limited to absorption facilities, alternative sewage disposal systems, effluent sewers, nonwater-carried sewage disposal facilities, septic tanks and subsurface sewage disposal systems as those terms are defined in ORS 454.605.
 - (2) The department shall complete the study and report its findings in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related the environment no later than October 1, 2018.
