

House Bill 3048

Sponsored by Representative HUFFMAN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits person from operating unmanned aircraft system, commonly known as drone, so that drone comes within 50 feet of individual without consent of individual. Establishes exceptions. Makes violation punishable by \$1,000 fine.

2 Relating to unmanned aircraft systems.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 837.300 to**
5 **837.390.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a person may not**
7 **operate an unmanned aircraft system so that the unmanned flying machine comes within 50**
8 **feet of any individual without the consent of the individual.**

9 **(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to:**

10 **(a) An unmanned flying machine that is taking off or landing.**

11 **(b) Use of an unmanned aircraft system by a law enforcement agency under ORS 837.335.**

12 **(3) Violation of subsection (1) of this section is a Class B violation.**
