Requires public employer to publish collective bargaining agreement.

2	Relating to public employer's publication of collective bargaining agreement.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 243.650 to
5	243.782.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A public employer shall publish a current collective bargaining agreemen
7	within 24 hours of executing the agreement, as follows:
8	(a) On the public employer's website;
9	(b) In a manner that is publicly accessible in the main office of the public employer; and
10	(c) On the Oregon transparency website.
11	(2) A collective bargaining agreement executed without the publication required under
12	this section is voidable by any party to the agreement.
13	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies to collective bargaining agreements entered
14	into on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.
