SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to identify and adopt procedures for reporting and collecting data related to acts of harassment, intimidation or bullying and acts of cyberbullying.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to reporting procedures related to hostile educational environments.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 339.351 to 339.364.

SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Education shall identify and adopt procedures for reporting and collecting data related to acts of harassment, intimidation or bullying and acts of cyberbullying and shall require school districts to comply with the procedures.

(2) The procedures adopted under subsection (1) of this section must, at a minimum, require school districts to:

(a) Make biennial reports to the department relating to:

(A) The number of reported acts of harassment, intimidation or bullying and acts of cyberbullying of students in kindergarten through grade 12 on the basis of a protected class, disaggregated based on protected class.

(B) The number of students in kindergarten through grade 12 who reported an act of harassment, intimidation or bullying or an act of cyberbullying on the basis of a protected class, disaggregated based on protected class.

(C) The number of students in kindergarten through grade 12 for whom there were consequences or remedial actions resulting from a confirmed act of harassment, intimidation or bullying or a confirmed act of cyberbullying on the basis of a protected class, disaggregated based on protected class.

(b) Confirm that the school district has adopted the policy required under ORS 339.356.

(c) Track reports related to acts of harassment, intimidation or bullying and acts of cyberbullying through an electronic system that allows for immediate retrieval of data related to the reports.

(3) Each biennium, the department shall submit a report based on the data collected from the biennial reports described in subsection (2)(a) of this section to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education.
