SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study expenditure of public moneys on alcohol and drug treatment and report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to treatment funded by public moneys.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study, track and account**
5 **for all public moneys appropriated for and expended on the provision of alcohol and drug**
6 **treatment.**

7 (2) The commission shall, when performing the study described in subsection (1) of this
8 section, examine:

9 (a) Treatment provided by state agencies and other public entities;

10 (b) Treatment provided by private entities through contracts with public entities; and

11 (c) Outcomes of each type of treatment and, specifically, the effect of outcomes on the
12 criminal justice system.

13 (3) The Oregon Health Authority, the Department of Human Services, the Department
14 of Corrections and the Oregon Youth Authority shall assist the commission in the perform-
15 ance of the study described in this section and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to
16 confidentiality, furnish information the commission considers necessary to perform the
17 study.

18 (4) The commission shall submit a report detailing the results of the study to the interim
19 committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided by
20 ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2019.
