

# Senate Bill 440

Sponsored by Senator FERRIOLI (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to prepare list related to high-wage and high-demand jobs in state, distribute list to school districts and award grants to school districts to ensure list is distributed to students in grades 9 through 12.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the distribution of job lists to students; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Education shall:**

5 (1) **Prepare, in consultation with the Bureau of Labor and Industries and the Higher**  
6 **Education Coordinating Commission, an annual list of:**

7 (a) **High-wage and high-demand jobs in this state;**

8 (b) **The projected need for jobs identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection;**

9 (c) **The projected salary of jobs identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection;**

10 (d) **The training programs or college programs in this state that can lead to the jobs**  
11 **identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection; and**

12 (e) **The projected costs associated with the training programs or college programs iden-**  
13 **tified under paragraph (d) of this subsection;**

14 (2) **Distribute to school districts the list prepared under subsection (1) of this section;**  
15 **and**

16 (3) **Award grants to school districts to ensure that the list received by the school dis-**  
17 **tricts under subsection (2) of this section is distributed to students in grades 9 through 12.**

18 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
19 **ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the**  
20 **General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, which shall be expended for the purposes described**  
21 **in section 1 of this 2017 Act.**

22 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
23 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
24 **July 1, 2017.**
