## Senate Bill 602

Sponsored by Senator KNOPP (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Allows local government meeting certain requirements of statewide land use planning goal relating to economic activity to waive requirements of goals as necessary to establish and maintain five-year supply of shovel-ready employment sites.

## 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to shovel-ready employment sites.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 195.
  - **SECTION 2.** (1) As used in this section:
  - (a) "Buildable lands" means vacant land or developed land likely to be redeveloped that is in an urban or urbanizable area and is suitable, available and necessary for industrial and commercial uses.
  - (b) "Shovel-ready buildable lands" means buildable lands that will be ready for construction within one year from the date an application for a building permit or for a request for extension of urban services, as defined in ORS 195.065, to a site is submitted.
  - (2) For the purpose of providing an adequate supply of sites for a variety of industrial and commercial uses as described in a statewide land use planning goal relating to economic activity, a local government may waive the requirements of any goals as necessary to establish and maintain a five-year supply of shovel-ready buildable lands for industrial and commercial uses, including sites of suitable sizes, types, and locations with urban services service levels for a variety of industrial and commercial uses.

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
