SUMMARY

Expands list of state agencies, entities and officials required to designate liaisons to coordinate emergency preparedness and response functions with Office of Emergency Management.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 401.054 is amended to read:

6 401.054. (1) Each of the following [*state*] agencies, **entities and officials** shall designate an in-
7 dividual [*within the agency*] to act as a liaison with the Office of Emergency Management:

8 (a) The Department of Consumer and Business Services;

9 (b) The Department of Corrections;

10 **(c) The Department of Education;**

11 [*(c)*] **(d)** The Department of Environmental Quality;

12 [*(d)*] **(e)** The Department of Human Services;

13 [*(e)*] **(f)** The Department of Justice;

14 [*(f)*] **(g)** The Department of Land Conservation and Development;

15 **(h) The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training;**

16 **(i) The Department of State Lands;**

17 [*(g)*] **(j)** The Department of State Police;

18 [*(h)*] **(k)** The Department of Transportation;

19 **(L) The Department of Veterans' Affairs;**

20 **(m) The Employment Department;**

21 **(n) The Housing and Community Services Department;**

22 [*(i)*] **(o)** The Judicial Department;

23 **(p) The Oregon Business Development Department;**

24 [*(j)*] **(q)** The Oregon Department of Administrative Services;

14 (2) Each [state] agency, **entity and official** required to designate a liaison under this section
15 shall designate an individual who has authority during an emergency to allocate resources and as-
16 sets of the agency, **entity or official**.

17 (3) Each individual designated as a liaison under subsection (1) of this section shall assist in the
18 coordination of the functions of the [individual's] agency, **entity or official that designated the**
19 **individual** that relate to emergency preparedness and response with similar functions of the Office
20 of Emergency Management.

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
