## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 204

1 Delete lines 4 through 23 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1)(a) Every school district, school and educator in
this state must be certified in culturally responsive practices and
competencies.

"(b) For the purpose of certifying school districts, schools and educators, the culturally responsive certification program is established
in the Department of Education.

"(2) The purposes of the certification program established by this
section are to improve student academic growth and achievement by:
"(a) Promoting a culture of leadership and collaborative responsibility for advancing culturally responsive practices of teaching by
working with providers of early learning services, teachers and administrators in kindergarten through grade 12, education service districts and educator preparation providers;

"(b) Promoting a culture for safe and inclusive learning environ ments by encouraging collaboration among students and families and
 by seeking input from students and families in evaluating cultural
 responsiveness;

"(c) Strengthening and enhancing existing evidence-based practices
 that are culturally responsive and that improve student achievement,
 improve the school environment and provide students and parents

1 with the ability to give input and cause change;

"(d) Strengthening and enhancing evidence-based practices that are
not described in paragraph (c) of this subsection and that improve
student achievement, including practices advanced by or described in
ORS 329.788 to 329.820, 329.824, 329.838, 342.433 to 342.449 and 342.805 to
342.937; and

"(e) Ensuring that the policies described in ORS 329.492, 336.113 and
342.950 are being implemented and enhance equity in education.

9 "(3)(a) The department shall administer the certification program 10 established by this section in collaboration with an organization that 11 has the mission to educate, inspire and engage teachers, administra-12 tors, parents, students and community organizations about the im-13 portance and need for culturally responsive practices.

"(b) In addition to the entity identified in paragraph (a) of this
 subsection, the department may collaborate with:

"(A) Public post-secondary institutions of education in this state;
 and

18 "(B) The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.

"(c) The department shall collaborate with the entity identified in
 paragraph (a) of this subsection to:

"(A) Develop the requirements for certification under this section;
 and

"(B) Review the policies and practices of educational state agencies
 to ensure that educators in this state provide instruction that is cul turally responsive and culturally relevant.

"(4)(a) The requirements for certification under this section must
 attempt to:

"(A) Strengthen the knowledge, skills and disposition of educators
 with respect to culturally responsive practices in classrooms and by
 administrators.

"(B) Refine the support, assistance and professional growth opportunities offered to educators, based on the individual needs of the educators, the students, the school and the school district.

"(C) Allow each educator to collaborate with students and parents
to establish a set of classroom or administrative practices and student
learning objectives that are based on culturally responsive practices
and on individual circumstances.

"(D) Establish a formative growth process for educators by supporting professional learning and collaboration with other educators.

"(E) Use evaluation methods, professional development, profes sional support and other activities that are based on research-based
 standards and that are targeted to the needs of students and families.
 "(b) The certification shall:

"(A) Take into consideration multiple measures of teacher effec tiveness around culturally responsive practices, based on widely ac cepted standards of teaching that encompass a range of appropriate
 teaching behaviors and that use multiple evaluation methods.

"(B) Take into consideration evidence of students' experiences by
 providing students and parents with the ability to give input and cause
 change about indicators related to academics, behavior and the school
 environment.

22 "(C) Be research based.

"(D) Be separately developed for school districts, schools, teachers
 and administrators.

"(E) Be able to be customized for each school district, which may
 include individualized weighting and application of standards.

"(5) The department shall provide technical support, in collab oration with the entities identified in subsection (3) of this section, in
 relation to the certification program established by this section. The
 technical support may include:

"(a) Assisting schools and school districts in measuring the effectiveness of educators in relation to their culturally responsive practices;

"(b) Providing statewide support in professional development for
educators in prekindergarten through post-secondary education for the
purpose of improving culturally responsive practices and competencies; and

"(c) Identifying methods for providing students and parents the
ability to give input and cause change, including the use of surveys.

"SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2017 Act becomes operative July
1, 2018.

"(2) Section 1 of this 2017 Act first applies to the 2018-2019 school
year.

"SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding the operative date specified in section 2 of this 2017 Act, the Department of Education may take any action before the operative date specified in section 2 of this 2017 Act that is necessary for the department to exercise, on or after the operative date specified in section 2 of this 2017 Act, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2017 Act.

"(2) For the purpose of implementing the certification program es-21tablished in section 1 of this 2017 Act, the department shall conduct a 22needs assessment for every school district, school and educator re-23quired to be certified in culturally responsive practices and compe-24tencies. If a school district, school or educator meets the requirements 25for certification, the department shall certify the school district, 26school or educator. Certification may be provided before the operative 27date specified in section 2 of this 2017 Act. 28

"(3) For the purpose of the needs assessment and certification pro cess described in subsection (2) of this section, the department shall

collaborate with an organization that has the mission to educate, inspire and engage teachers, administrators, parents, students and
community organizations about the importance and need for culturally responsive practices.

5 "(4) The department shall submit a report, and may include rec-6 ommendations for legislation, to an interim committee of the Legis-7 lative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2017. 8 The report shall summarize the actions takes by the department to 9 implement the certification program established by section 1 of this 10 2017 Act, including a summary of the needs assessments conducted 11 under subsection (2) of this section.

"SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2017 Act is repealed on June 30, 2018.
"SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$400,000, which may be expended for the certification program established by section 1 of this 2017 Act.

"SECTION 6. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.".
