PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3135

1 Delete lines 5 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 414.065 and 414.690, medical assistance must reimburse, at a rate specified by the Oregon Health
Authority, the cost to:

"(1) Insert, postpartum, an intrauterine device or a progestin implant in an individual who is eligible for medical assistance while the
individual is admitted to a hospital for labor and delivery; and

8 "(2) Remove, at any time, an intrauterine device or progestin im-9 plant reimbursed under subsection (1) of this section regardless of 10 whether the individual is eligible for medical assistance.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) For the 24-month period following the effective
 date of this 2017 Act, the Oregon Health Authority shall evaluate the
 impact of section 2 of this 2017 Act on the:

"(a) Utilization of long acting contraceptives by medical assistance
 recipients who are of reproductive age;

"(b) Satisfaction of women of reproductive age with the
 contraceptive services available in the medical assistance program;

19 "(d) Total cost of the medical assistance program.

"(2) No later than July 1, 2019, the authority shall report its findings
 for the first 12 months of the period described in subsection (1) of this

section to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related
 to health.

"(3) No later than July 1, 2020, the authority shall report its findings
for the entire period described in subsection (1) of this section to the
interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health.
"<u>SECTION 4.</u> Section 3 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2,
2021.".

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
