PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3293

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 9 and insert:

² **"SECTION 1.** ORS 339.450 is amended to read:

3 "339.450. (1) As used in this section:

4 "(a) 'Interscholastic activities' has the meaning given that term in
5 ORS 339.460.

6 "(b) 'Interscholastic association' means a public or private volun-7 tary organization that administers interscholastic activities or that 8 facilitates the scheduling and programming of interscholastic activ-9 ities.

"(2) [No] A school[,] or school district [or association, whether public or private, shall] may not deny any grade or high school student the right to participate in interscholastic athletics solely on the ground that the student transferred between schools, attends a public charter school or participated in athletics at another school.

15 "(3) A school or school district shall ensure that, to the extent 16 practicable, all students who attend public schools, including public 17 charter schools, or who are homeschooled have access to interscho-18 lastic activities and the ability to fully engage in interscholastic ac-19 tivities for the purpose of maximizing students' physical and academic 20 growth.

21 "(4) To improve students' access to interscholastic activities and

students' ability to fully engage in interscholastic activities, schools
 and school districts must allow:

"(a) Coaches or program advisers to oversee students in more than
one school or school district;

5 "(b) Coaches to coordinate athletic training or program advisers to
6 collaborate on preparation for competitions;

7 "(c) Students to access interscholastic activities through another
8 school or school district;

9 "(d) Students to access interscholastic activities without affiliation
10 with another school or school district, either as individuals or as a
11 group of students without an affiliation; and

"(e) Students to participate in interscholastic activities without
 limit, as long as the students meet eligibility requirements.

"(5) Schools and school districts shall, to the extent practicable,
 become members and pay fees to an interscholastic association only
 if the interscholastic association:

"(a) Adopts rules or policies that allow schools and school districts
 to comply with the provisions of this section; and

"(b) Charges fees proportionately to the level of access a student
 will have to interscholastic activities.".
