PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 56

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, delete "declaring an emergency" and 2 insert "prescribing an effective date".

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part
5 of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395.

6 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Legislative Assembly finds and declares that 7 the unregulated commerce of marijuana items constitutes a serious 8 danger to public health and safety.

"(2) In addition to any other disciplinary action available to the 9 Oregon Liquor Control Commission under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395, 10 the commission may immediately restrict, suspend or refuse to renew 11 a license issued under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395 if circumstances create 12probable cause for the commission to conclude that a licensee has 13 purchased or received a marijuana item from an unlicensed source or 14 that a licensee has sold, stored or transferred a marijuana item in a 15manner that is not permitted by the licensee's license. 16

"SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
 date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative
 Assembly adjourns sine die.".
