- 4 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 21 and insert:
- **"SECTION 4.** ORS 457.095 is amended to read:
 - "457.095. (1) An urban renewal plan may not be carried out unless the urban renewal agency forwards a copy of the proposed plan and report required under ORS 457.085 to the governing body of the municipality and to the governing bodies of all other municipalities and taxing districts with jurisdiction in all urban renewal areas included in the plan.
 - "(2) The governing body of the municipality, upon receipt of [a proposed urban renewal] the plan and report [from the municipality's urban renewal agency and after public notice and hearing and] under subsection (1) of this section, shall provide public notice as required under ORS 457.115 and 457.120 and hold public hearings regarding the plan and report.
- "(3) After consideration of public testimony and planning commission recommendations, if any, the governing body may [approve the urban renewal plan. The approval shall be by nonemergency ordinance which shall incorporate the plan by reference.] order an election to be held on the question of approval of the plan. The election must be held on the

- same date in all municipalities and taxing districts in which any part 1 of an urban renewal area included in the plan is located. 2
- "(4) Before a plan may be approved by the governing body of the 3 municipality, a majority of the voters in each municipality and taxing 4 district must approve the plan at the election held pursuant to sub-5 section (3) of this section. 6
- "(5) If the voters of each municipality and taxing district approve 7 the plan, the governing body of the municipality shall, by non-8 emergency ordinance, declare the approval of the plan, incorporating the plan by reference.
- "(6)(a) [Notice of adoption of the ordinance approving the urban renewal 11 plan, and the provisions of ORS 457.135, shall be published by the governing 12 body of the municipality in accordance with ORS 457.115 no later than four 13 days following the ordinance adoption.] The ordinance adopted under sub-14 **section (5) of this section must** [shall] include determinations and findings 15 by the governing body that: 16
- "[(1)] (A) Each urban renewal area is blighted; 17

- "[(2)] (B) The rehabilitation and redevelopment is necessary to protect the 18 public health, safety or welfare of the municipality; 19
 - "[(3)] (C) The urban renewal plan conforms to the comprehensive plan and economic development plan, if any, of the municipality as a whole and provides an outline for accomplishing the urban renewal projects the urban renewal plan proposes;
- "[(4)] (**D**) Provision has been made to house displaced persons within their 24 financial means in accordance with ORS 35.500 to 35.530 and, except in the 25relocation of elderly individuals or individuals with disabilities, without 26 displacing on priority lists persons already waiting for existing federally 27 subsidized housing; 28
- "[(5)] (E) If acquisition of real property is provided for, that it is neces-29 sary; 30

- "[(6)] (**F**) Adoption and carrying out of the urban renewal plan is economically sound and feasible; and
- "[(7)] (G) The municipality shall assume and complete any activities prescribed it by the urban renewal plan.
 - "(b) Notice of adoption of the ordinance approving the urban renewal plan, and the provisions of ORS 457.135, must be published by the governing body of the municipality in accordance with ORS 457.115 no later than four days following the adoption of the ordinance."

- **"SECTION 7.** ORS 457.125 is amended to read:
- "457.125. (1) A copy of the ordinance approving an urban renewal plan under ORS 457.095 (5) shall be sent by the governing body of the municipality to the urban renewal agency. [A copy of the resolution approving an urban renewal plan under ORS 457.105 shall be sent by the governing body of a municipality to the urban renewal agency.]
- "(2) Upon receipt of [the necessary approval of each municipality governing body] the copy required under this section, the urban renewal plan shall be recorded by the urban renewal agency with the recording officer of each county in which any portion of an urban renewal area within the plan is situated.
 - **"SECTION 7a.** ORS 457.055 is amended to read:
- "457.055. [At any time following adoption of the ordinance under ORS 457.035, or] For urban renewal agencies activated before [October 3, 1979] the effective date of this 2017 Act, [at any time following adoption of a proper resolution or ordinance of the governing body of the municipality,] the governing body of [a] the municipality may, by ordinance, transfer the authority to exercise the powers of the urban renewal agency to [any other body] a board authorized to exercise those powers under ORS 457.045. All duties and obligations of the urban renewal agency shall thereafter be assumed by the [body to which those powers are transferred] board.

- 2 "457.065. For the purpose of coordinating its activities and undertakings
