Please support House Bill 4003.

We know that diesel pollution:

- causes more fatalities than traffic crashes
- puts Oregonians at heightened risk of cancer in at least 17 Oregon counties
- damages the heart, lungs and brain
- is at highest concentration in neighborhoods with more low-income and people-of-color residents (Think North Portland near the Minnesota Freeway aka Interstate 5)

Furthermore, we know the following concerning facts:

- Oregon has become a dumping ground for dirty diesel engines because our state lags behind others in regulating diesel and funding diesel cleanup. We need to prohibit the sale of pre-2007 engines in Oregon and adopt standards to accelerate the purchase of cleaner engines (including electric vehicles and equipment).
- Diesel <u>harms our health</u>, from heart disease to cancer, from asthma attacks to neurological problems, diesel is one of the most dangerous, insidious, and widespread air pollutants.
- Vulnerable individuals include children, the elderly, people whose health is already compromised, and people living in neighborhoods with higher than average numbers of low-income families and people of color.
- Diesel contributes to climate change--diesel soot is a <u>black carbon</u>.
- Diesel is an <u>occupational hazard</u>.
