I am concerned about the effects that diesel fuel has on my family's health, especially because I live in North Portland - above Swan Island and all of it's industrial activity. Several times per week my family encounters noxious odors, especially when the winds are blowing from the south from the fall thru spring. I mostly smell paint fumes, but I know there are plenty of diesel engines there contributing to the detriment of my family's health.

We know that diesel pollution:

- puts Oregonians at heightened risk of cancer in at least 17 Oregon counties
- damages the heart, lungs and brain
- is at highest concentration in neighborhoods with more low-income and people-of-color residents

Rep. Nosse has introduced <u>House Bill 4003</u>: cleaning up dirty diesel engines.
