Please find the letter below in the form of written testimony for HB 4066, on the agenda for tomorrow's meeting of the Committee on Early Childhood and Family Support.

The original letter is in Spanish, and can be found in the forwarded message below. A translation is provided here:

To Whom it May Concern -

My name is Lucinda Morales I am the mother of Brenda Miranda Morales. We have attended the Juntos Aprendemos program of Latino Network for two years. This program has been a benefit to my family and my community in Metzger School in the Tualatin-Tigard District, given that in this district there are very few programs and our families don't have access due to diverse situations of programs that are over capacity in the area. Another factor is that families don't always meet all of the requirements to qualify for these programs.

Juntos Aprendemos is a program that benefits us, since our children receive education during their first years of life which builds future students who are able to access curriculum more easily. The main focus is that the language of instruction is Spanish, which makes it so the children can learn in a natural way, since it is the first language that is used at home. The Juntos Aprendemos program also helps to strengthen the culture that we have from our countries, as during the school year culture is promoted through activities that are used in our countries. On the other hand, also very important is the support that is given to the parents with topics like how to raise our children during this important stage of their lives, with various topics including communication, stages of development, self esteem, culture, how to raise successful kids, among others.

We want our program to not only continue in our school but also to be implemented in every school in the Portland and Tigard-Tualatin districts, as this would give more families the opportunity to have access to education for their 3-5 year old children. Our program needs support from the legislature to help in the early childhood of our children. Juntos Aprendemos has been a great support to the early learning in Oregon's public schools.
