While I can not be there in person - I'd like to register my dissatisfaction at some of the provisions in the bill. First I feel it opens up the description of those prohibited, way too far. By the terms stated, almost anyone can file for an order and you lose your rights to own or possess. Just like the law passed that allows guns to be taken on a suspicion, there is no constitutional order here. Ever heard of "presumed innocent, until proven guilty"? Just seems like more putting the "cart before the horse" type of legislation. I am for people with Psyche issues being better screened for possession and stronger background checks, in general. Just seems to me that this bill being discussed, opens up too many ways to take away people's rights to own.
