I am a native Oregonian who has spent many hours of my life enjoying the beautiful Deschutes River and was grateful when portions of it were designated as both a State Scenic Waterway and a Federal Wild and Scenic River. Although I am generally a supporter of Bend Parks and Recreation, I emphatically part company with them here. Any proposed developments including another bridge would weaken protections and this is not OK with me at all--and as concerning, would set alarming precedents.
