WHY NOW?

If not now when? Delay will add costs and cause more farmland to be used in bad locations. Passage now will allow Hillsboro and North Plains to collaborate on long range planning. Hillsboro is moving ahead with infrastructure planning to serve the area added to the UGB by HB4078. Given that North Plains has commenced with planning for the next 20 years the infrastructure planning needs to be done in cooperation with Hillsboro. Much of the infrastructure planning will be done in the wrong way unless North Hillsboro is included in the Urban Reserve. Please consider passing HB 4075 in the 2018 legislative session.
