I am unable to make to the Hearing Room 50, where the House Judiciary Committee is scheduled to hear HB 415.

I am writing in opposition to this bill for the way it is written making reference to supposed family members.

How can responsible individuals write a bill like this? The language of this bill is absolutely insane.

Members of the immediate family includes spouses, parents, brothers, sisters, sons and/or daughters. Members of the extended family may include **grandparents**, **aunts**, **uncles**, **cousins**, **nephews**, **nieces and/or siblings-in-law**. Including other

individuals identified in the wording of the bill is a stretch of the imagination. I strongly protest HB415 as it is attempt to be a catch-all and include anyone the sponsor wishes to identify as a family member.

No responsible caring representative should be allowed to submit a bill written like HB415.

You are doing a disservice to the Oregon citizens by submitting HB415 as it is written. I am a concerned Oregon citizen. Freedom isn't free, I want my voice heard.
