- 193,000 people live in poverty in Washington and Multnomah counties
 - 31% of all people in poverty in Oregon
 - 40% of all people of color in poverty in Oregon

How It Works...



- Occupational training and job placement in target industries for 1000 local residents
- Restored federal employment and training funds for individuals in Poverty.

WHAT?

- 1,000 Oregonians will be served
- 1000% living in poverty

WHO?

- 80% will come from areas of persistent poverty
- 50% immigrants and/or people of color

Outcome:

- 80% complete training
- 75% are placed in employment
- 75% earn at lest \$15/hour

Financial

• \$3,125,000 in federal match generated and reinvested into the public workforce system
