-We live in southwest bend and drive 20-30 minutes across the nearest road bridge to access phenomenal trails along the west side of the river. Having a footbridge would allow us to walk or bike ride to the trails.

- I feel that the bridge would be a huge improvement for all residents who currently live on the east side of the river, providing connectivity to the river's existing trails, and help reduce vehicular traffic.
