Measure Description:

Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to biennially report to Legislative Assembly regarding estimated change in wolf population.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA), Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to submit biennial report to the Legislative Assembly on estimated net change in wolf population during the preceding two-year period. In addition, the bill requires the Legislative Assembly to identify the level of assistance sufficient to carry out essential features related to wolf depredation.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
