Manure collector/producer for biofuel	-5 Includes changes in introduced version with added clarification for bovine manure to mean cattle manure. Cattle specified to mean: cows, heifers, bulls, steers or calves.
Affordable Housing Lenders Credit	-1 No further changes expected. Includes new requirement through which entities may be considered a qualified borrower on a loan to finance a manufactured dwelling park to include a nonprofit corporation or housing authority that has a controlling interest in the real property that is financed by a qualified loan.
