Subject:HB 4010 – Relating to home ownershipWork Session Recommendations

HB 4010 establishes the 11-member Task Force on Addressing Racial Disparities in Home Ownership charged with making recommendations for changes in lending practices to eliminate discrimination and remove barriers to home ownership for people of color in Oregon. The bill requires the task force to report to the Legislature by September 15, 2019. The task force sunsets December 31, 2019.

The measure previously had hearings in the House Committee on Human Services and Housing on 2/8/2018 and 2/9/2018.

Fiscal impact

The bill requires the Legislative Policy and Research Office (LPRO) to provide staff support to the task force. The 2017-19 Legislative Branch budget should contain funds allocated for LPRO support of interim committees and task forces.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 4010 be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
