

## FINANCIAL AID SUMMARY JUNE 2017

## 2016 Fall Enrollment at Oregon State University:

- 24,696 undergraduates (approx. 29% independent & 71% dependent)
- 4,340 graduate and professional students
- 16,738 undergraduate students are from Oregon (68%)

## '16-'17 Federal & State Student Aid at OSU:

- 7,732 Students received Pell Grants that totaled \$29,421,595
- <u>4,337 Students received Oregon Opportunity Grants that totaled \$8,449,580</u>
- 522 Students earned \$977,593 under the Federal Work Study program
- 1,757 Students received Federal SEOG Grants that totaled \$1,244,722
- 2,118 Students received Perkins Loans that totaled \$5,267,099
- 13,385 Students received Ford Direct Loans that totaled \$140,462,029
- 15,574 Students received some form of Federal aid that totaled \$177,373,038
- Direct Loan Cohort Default Rate 3.8% (FY 2014)

Of <u>all</u> of the financial aid distributed (federal, state, university and other) in the '16-'17 academic year, OSU students received a total of \$252,888,266 in aid.
