- The person appointed as director shall be well qualified by training and experience to perform the functions of the office.
- Director shall give to the state a fidelity bond with one or more corporate sureties authorized to do business in this state, or an irrevocable letter of credit issued by an insured institution, in either case in the penal sum fixed by the Governor.

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 705.115 – 705.139

- Organize and reorganize the Department of Consumer and Business Services, with the approval of the Governor in the manner the director considers necessary to conduct the work of the department properly.
- Appoint supervisors for each division or office of the department, with the approval of the Governor.
- Appoint all subordinate officers and employees of the department, prescribe their functions and fix their compensation.
- Establish within the department a Consumer Advocacy Section not later than January 1, 1988
- Delegate any duties, powers and functions
- Adopt rules for the purpose of carrying out the functions of the department.
- Enter into agreements with other state, federal, foreign and international regulatory and law enforcement agencies
