 - A representative of the news media who is a member in good standing of a professional journalism association (SUO);
 - o Two additional representatives of the news media (VAN DER VOO and ZAITZ):
 - A representative of the cities (WINKELS);
 - A representative of the counties (BOVETT);
 - o A representative of the special districts (LANDAUER);
 - A representative of the public sector workforce (KHOSRAVI);
 - A member of the public (HERNANDEZ);
 - A Senator who is appointed by the President of the Senate and who serves as an ex officio nonvoting member (); and
 - A Representative who is appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and who serves as an ex officio nonvoting member ().
- Four year terms eligible for reappointment, maximum of two terms;
- Public Records Advocate is chair of the council;
- Nominates three qualified individuals to the Governor for Public Records Advocate;
- Council will meet at least once every six months and at other times and places specified by the call of the chair or of a majority of the members.

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: Senate Bill 106, 2017

- Survey state agency, other jurisdictions and public body practices and procedures for:
 - Receiving public records requests, identifying the existence of records responsive to the requests and gathering and disclosing responsive records;
 - o Determining fee estimates and imposing or waiving fees; and
 - o Determining and applying exemptions from required disclosure.
- Identify inefficiencies and inconsistencies in application of the public records law that impede transparency in public process and government;

- Make recommendations on changes in law, policy or practice that could enhance transparency in public process and government, and facilitate rapid dissemination of public records to requesters;
- Make recommendations on the role of the Public Records Advocate as facilitator in disputes between custodians of public records and public record requesters;
- Report to Governor and Legislature by December 1 of each even-numbered year describing the findings of the council since the council's last report including recommendations for legislation.
