Extends sunset date for nonresident open enrollment by one year, to July 1, 2020. Clarifies timing of implementation.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon's open enrollment law will sunset on July 1, 2019. Senate Bill 1521-A extends that date by one year. Open enrollment allows students who reside in one school district to attend school in a different district, under certain circumstances.
