SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Adjusts certain fees imposed by Department of Transportation.

Reorganizes laws related to motor vehicle registration, titling, driving privileges and vehicle business certificates.

17 (6) To reinstate driving privileges or the right to apply for driving privileges after the depart-18 ment determines that the person meets the objective criteria under subsection (4) of this section, the 19 person shall pay the fee for reinstatement of driving privileges as described in ORS 807.370 [(25)] 20 (10).

(7) To reinstate an identification card or the right to apply for an identification card after the
department determines that the person meets the objective criteria under subsection (4) of this section, the person shall pay the fee for reinstatement of an identification card as described in ORS
807.410 (4).

(8) The department's authority to reinstate a suspension of a person's driving privileges or right
to apply for driving privileges under this section does not impinge on a court's authority to impose
a suspension under ORS 165.805 or 471.430.
