(1) If requested to do so by a law enforcement agency, the Department of Transportation may issue or renew a fictitious driver license or identification card for a law enforcement offi-10 cial for use in discharging the undercover criminal investigative duties of the law enforcement 11 12agency. 13 "(2) The fees for issuance and renewal of a fictitious driver license or fictitious identification card issued under this section shall be the fees established for issuance and renewal of a driver li-14 cense under ORS 807.370 [and 807.375] or the fees established for issuance and renewal of an iden-1516 tification card under ORS 807.410. 17 "(3) The department may determine by rule: 18 "(a) What is considered a law enforcement agency for the purposes of this section; and 19 "(b) The criteria for making a request under this section. 20 "(4) The department may maintain a driving record under ORS 802.200 for a fictitious driver li-21cense or fictitious identification card issued under this section. (5) All information submitted to and maintained by the department regarding the true identity 22of a law enforcement official under this section is confidential. The department may only disclose 23 24 information regarding the true identity of a law enforcement official to a law enforcement agency 25upon request. "SECTION 9. ORS 807.375 is repealed.". 2627
