CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the starting date for regular sessions of the Legislative Assembly; amending ORS 171.010; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 171.010 is amended to read:

171.010. The regular sessions of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at the capital of the state and shall commence:

(1) In the case of an odd-numbered year regular session, on the Tuesday after the holiday for Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday.

(2) In the case of an even-numbered year regular session, on the first day of February [of each year], except that if the first day of February is a Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday, the regular session shall commence on the following Monday.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2018 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2018 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
