become operative on January 2, 2020.

20 "(3) The Attorney General, the Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative 21Services, the Director of Transportation and a contracting agency that adopts rules under 22ORS 279A.065 or 279A.070 may adopt rules and take any other action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the Attorney 23 24 General, the director or the contracting agency, on and after the operative date specified in 25subsection (1) of this section, to undertake or exercise all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the Attorney General, the director or the contracting agency under section 2 2627of this 2018 Act and the amendments to ORS 279B.060 and 279B.145 by sections 3 and 5 of this 282018 Act.
