PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4152

1 Delete lines 4 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The operator of a public campground may not enforce a limit on the duration of a stay in the public campground
against an individual or a member of the individual's immediate family if:

"(a) The individual has, within the preceding 24 hours, engaged in
work related to suppression of wildfire; and

8 "(b) The individual displays an unexpired incident qualification
9 card.

"(2) Nothing in this section prohibits an operator of a public
 campground from enforcing rules or regulations unrelated to limits
 on the duration of a stay.

13 **"(3) As used in this section:**

"(a) 'Incident qualification card' means a certification of qualifica tion to perform work related to fire suppression that is issued in co ordination with, and according to standards established by, a national
 wildfire coordinating group.

"(b) 'Public campground' means a site owned or operated by a unit
 of state or local government that is made available to the general
 public for overnight camping.

21 "(c) 'Wildfire' has the meaning given that term in ORS 477.089.

"SECTION 2. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, the De-1 partment of Transportation shall adopt rules that authorize the $\mathbf{2}$ movement on highways under the department's jurisdiction of 3 firefighting vehicles of a size or weight in excess of the limits under 4 ORS 818.020, 818.090 or 818.110, without requiring the operator of the 5 firefighting vehicle to obtain a variance or other permit before com-6 mencing the movement, when the firefighting vehicles are in transit 7to or from the site of a wildfire. 8

9 "(2) The department shall comply with this section only to the ex-10 tent possible without violating federal law or jeopardizing the quali-11 fication of the state for federal aid highway funds.

12 "(3) As used in this section:

"(a) 'Firefighting vehicle' means a vehicle that is used, or that
 carries equipment that is used, to suppress fire or to prevent loss of
 life or property from fire.
