#### Informational Meeting Brownfields in Oregon

#### Public Hearing

- HB 2613 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Business Development Department to prepare and report master plan for county fairground capital construction.
- HB 2699 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Provides that brownfield granted property tax incentive benefit under chapter 96, Oregon Laws 2016, is eligible for special assessment, exemption or partial exemption granted under other law for which such property is eligible.
- HB 2850  
Directs Department of Environmental Quality to conduct study to examine funding opportunities for supporting brownfield redevelopment efforts and report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources on or before September 15, 2020.

- HB 2132 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Extends sunset for tax credit for contributions to Trust for Cultural Development Account.
- HB 2173 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Creates Oregon Broadband Office within Oregon Business Development Department.
- HB 2184 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Expands definition of "retail telecommunications service" for purposes of universal service surcharge.
