- HB 2098 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes that recreational marijuana licensure renewal fees are nonrefundable if applicant is conditionally or unconditionally authorized to operate marijuana establishment.
- HB 2233 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Provides for regulation by Oregon Liquor Control Commission of consumption and sale of marijuana items at temporary events, including licensure of premises at which temporary events are conducted.
- HB 3211 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs State Department of Agriculture to advance design of cannabis business certification program.
