Public Hearing

- HB 2516 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Prohibits virtual public school from using moneys received as distributions from State School Fund or from other state or local public sources for paying expenses incurred for advertising or other promotional materials of school.
- HB 2676 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Increases threshold under which school district may receive additional State School Fund moneys for student eligible for special education.
- HB 2724
Prohibits sponsor or public charter school from entering into contract or other agreement with for-profit entity to provide specified percentage of educational services for public charter school.
- HB 2809 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish competency-based education pilot program.
- HJM 3
Urges Congress to fully fund federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

Work Session

- HB 2029
Revises types of programs considered accelerated college credit programs for purpose of requirement that school districts provide accelerated college credit programs.
- HB 2263 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success
Directs Department of Education, in collaboration with Higher Education Coordinating Commission, to administer Accelerated College Credit Planning Partnership Grant Program to encourage partnerships between school districts and post-secondary institutions of education to offer accelerated college credit programs.
- HB 2327 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success
Establishes Statewide School Safety and Prevention System.

Establishes Early Childhood Equity Fund.
