HB 3062 **

Extends sunset date for exemption from use fuel tax for diesel fuel blended with at least 20 percent biodiesel derived from used cooking oil.

HB 3065

Directs Public Utility Commission to establish public process for investigating continuing relevance of telecommunications carrier of last resort obligations.

HB 3114

Makes changes to requirements for recycling certain electronic devices.

HB 3182

Requires permit for construction, installation or operation of system for on-site treatment and reuse of nonpotable water.

HB 3325

Requires public utility to meet certain requirements for processing applications from nonresidential customergenerators to interconnect to electric distribution system net metering facility that has generating capacity of more th 25 kilowatts but less than two megawatts.
