Work Session

- HB 2329
Modifies definition of "energy facility" for purposes of regulation of energy facilities by Energy Facility Siting Council.
- HB 2509
Prohibits use of single-use checkout bags except in certain cases.
- HB 2618 **
Requires State Department of Energy to adopt by rule program for providing rebates for purchase, construction or installation of residential and commercial solar electric systems and paired solar and storage systems. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2819 **
Requires Water Resources Department to establish pilot program to make conserved Columbia River water available to holder of water right in critical ground water area in exchange for holder reducing appropriation of ground water. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2853
Requires Water Resources Department to maintain registry of historic-use reservoirs.
- HB 2860 **
Requires Oregon Health Authority to analyze ground water contaminant data and provide education in areas with ground water contaminant problems. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2883 **
Prohibits food vendor from using polystyrene container in selling, offering for sale, serving or dispensing prepared food to public. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2322
Requires Land Conservation and Development Commission to amend statewide land use planning goals related to energy to incorporate development of renewable energy facilities and reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and to match state energy policies.

- HB 3094 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Home Weatherization, Retrofit and Affordability Program for Housing and Community Services Department to provide incentive payments to construction contractors undertaking energy improvement projects on residential structures.
- HB 3141
Modifies and adds laws related to electric vehicle charging stations.
- HB 3157
Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to amend Low-Rise Residential Dwelling Code to require alternative energy collection or generation by December 15, 2020.
- HB 3174
Directs Public Utility Commission to require electricity or natural gas utility to provide analog meter option for residential customers.
