Public Hearing

- SB 107 A
Provides exemption to utility vehicles , when inspecting or repairing natural gas leak under certain circumstances, from offense of illegal stopping, standing or parking.
- SCR 1 A
Declares legislative support for closed-loop pump storage energy projects.
- SB 914 A
Requires certain distributors and importers to register with distributor cooperatives and provide certain information to distributor cooperatives.
- SB 637
Raises statutory threshold for requiring public utility to receive Public Utility Commission approval for disposition of certain property from \$100,000 to \$1 million.

Work Session

- SB 38
Modifies provisions for treatment of renewable energy certificates issued for generation of thermal energy.
