Public Hearing

- HB 2690
 - Establishes right of consumer to be educated about ways to reduce cost of prescription drugs.
- HB 2961

Requires manufacturer to disclose in any advertisement for prescription drug wholesale price in Oregon of prescription drug.

HB 2753

Requires pharmacist to substitute prescribed brand name drug with generic name drug product.

HB 2754

Requires pharmacy or pharmacist to substitute prescribed biological product with interchangeable biological product. HB 2755

Requires pharmacy or pharmacist to substitute prescribed brand name drug with generic name drug product and to substitute prescribed biological product with interchangeable biological product.

HB 2692

Requires Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee to publish on website of Oregon Health Authority within seven days recommendations concerning Practitioner-Managed Prescription Drug Plan.

HB 2678

Subject to exceptions, allows Oregon Health Authority to require prior authorization for prescription drugs, other than mental health drugs, that are not listed on Practitioner-Managed Prescription Drug Plan and that are reimbursed on fee-for-service basis.
