- HB 2563
Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules requiring infants to be screened to detect certain diseases.
- HB 2220
Authorizes trained and certified dentists to prescribe and administer vaccines.
- HB 2609
Requires prescription monitoring system established by Oregon Health Authority to be accessible to dental director appointed by authority.
- HB 2303
Deletes requirement that pseudoephedrine be classified as Schedule III controlled substance.
- HB 2831 **
Provides funding to peer-run organizations in Portland metropolitan area, southern Oregon region and eastern and central Oregon region to operate peer respite centers to provide peer respite services to individuals with mental illness who experience acute distress, anxiety or emotional pain. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Public Hearing

- HB 3075 **
Permits duplicate health benefit plan coverage for public employees. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 3074
Limits rate review process that invites public comment to process for approving rates for health benefit plans.
- HB 3095 **
Directs Department of Human Services to increase fee-for-service rate for behavioral health providers participating in medical assistance programs. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 3279 **
Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish uniform payment amounts applicable to medical assistance payments to providers of substance use disorder services and providers of mental health treatment. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 3165 **
Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide planning grants to 10 school districts or education service districts to evaluate community needs for school-based health services. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
