HB 2960  
Requires pharmacist to dispense controlled substance in Schedule II of federal Controlled Substances Act in lockable vial.

#### Work Session

HB 2217  
Prohibits anyone other than patient from administering medication to end patient's life in humane and dignified manner.

HB 2717 \*\*  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to take steps to limit cost to hospitals, ambulatory surgical centers and extended stay centers for compiling and reporting records and data. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2935 \*\*  
Requires pharmacies to notify person to whom prescription drug is dispensed of availability of prescription reader. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2017  
Directs Oregon Health Authority to study health care in this state.

HB 2627 \*\*  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to operate peer managed recovery centers in cities in this state with populations of 100,000 or more to provide peer mentor support and peer support services to individuals in recovery from addiction. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2600 \*\*  
CARRIED OVER FROM 04/04/2019 AGENDA: Requires long term care facilities and residential care facilities providing care to six or more residents to adopt specified protocols and procedures regarding preventing and reporting disease outbreaks. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2678  
CARRIED OVER FROM 04/04/2019 AGENDA: Subject to exceptions, allows Oregon Health Authority to require prior authorization for prescription drugs, other than mental health drugs, that are not listed on Practitioner-Managed Prescription Drug Plan and that are reimbursed on fee-for-service basis.

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
