HB 2626 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2131 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Prescribes amount of expenses for which tax credit for employment-related dependent care expenses may be claimed by removing limitations based on earned income of individual spouse, in case of joint tax filers.

HB 2139 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Extends sunset for earned income tax credit.

HB 2508 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Department of Human Services to award grants to refugee resettlement agencies to provide specified services to refugees.
