#### **Public Hearing**

HB 2524

Requires long term care facilities, residential facilities and adult foster homes to inform residents about availability and services of Long Term Care Ombudsman and Residential Facilities Ombudsman.

HB 2569

Directs Department of Human Services to assign exactly one universal provider number to persons listed on registry of persons who provide long term care.

HB 2601

Limits guardian's authority to limit protected person's preferred associations with third parties.

HB 2827

Repeals limitations on eligibility of persons who are 18 years of age or older who have physical disabilities to receive benefits from Oregon Project Independence.
